Mayor Alsberry and the Village are committed to transparency at all stages, and will make data and related activities available to the community. As the initial project partners work on identifying goals to accomplish, the data needs and opportunities for community participation will expand. Programming will be multifaceted and public safety will be co-produced with multiple local stakeholders and perspectives involved.

Ultimately the data and outcomes will be part of a larger Village of Hazel Crest initiative to create expansive transparency tools that will be accessible by the community for their ongoing utilization as well. More information about these and other goals will be shared regularly, and also driven as desired by events that facilitate receiving community needs and requests. The Village of Hazel Crest will be additionally supported by Research Improving People's Lives (RIPL), a tech-for-social-impact nonprofit that works with governments to help them use data, science, and technology to improve policy and lives. RIPL scientists and engineers will help the Village understand and unlock its data for insights, and deliver access to accurate, timely data for Hazel Crest community members and policymakers.

It's a very exciting time, and Mayor Alsberry and the Village of Hazel Crest are looking forward to co-producing meaningful outcomes with the community to address our most important and pressing issues in equitable and socially-just ways. Our initial efforts will focus on transparency in public safety through community engagement. Information on meetings centered on receiving input from community members and stakeholders will be posted on the Village of Hazel Crest website, the e-newsletter, and other forms of community information sharing in the coming weeks. We look forward to working together with our residents on this innovative, unique, and impactful transparency project.
